

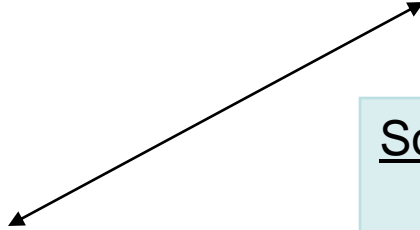
Video Conferencing

Video Conferencing

allows two or more remote locations to communicate with video and audio as if they were in the same room.



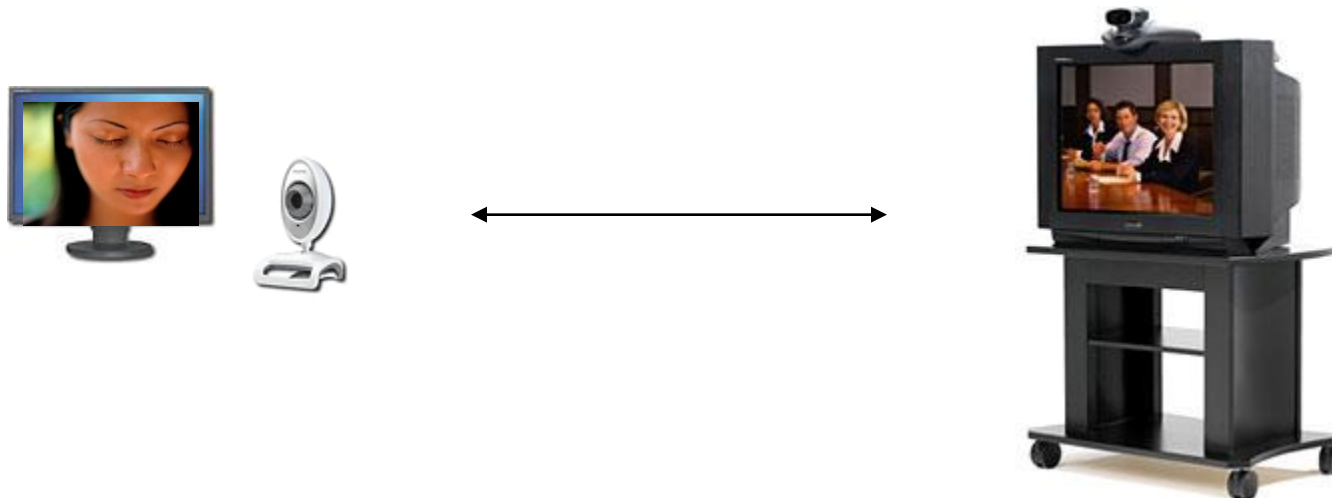
Some Examples:

- A small classroom holds a video conference with another small classroom in Senora Mexico
- A department head from Eller holds a video conference with a department head from another University to discuss a joint venture
- An MBA student conducts an initial interview with a company via a video conference session.

Desktop to Desktop Video Conference (point-to-point)



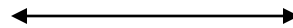
Desktop to Mobile Video Conference (point-to-point)
